

**2026 Premier Pools Pigskin Pick'em
OFFICIAL RULES AND LEGAL DISCLAIMER**

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. A PURCHASE OR PAYMENT WILL NOT INCREASE AN ENTRANT'S CHANCE OF WINNING.

ALL CONTESTS ARE SUBJECT TO AND GOVERNED BY APPLICABLE FEDERAL, STATE, AND LOCAL LAWS, STATUTES AND REGULATIONS. PARTICIPATION IN THIS CONTEST IS VOID WHERE PROHIBITED OR OTHERWISE RESTRICTED BY LAW.

1. By entering, attempting to enter, or in any way participating or attempting to participate in the 2026 Premier Pools Pigskin Pick'em Contest (the "Contest"), the participant ("Participant") agrees to be bound by these Official Rules and Legal Disclaimer and the decisions of Bonneville International Corporation ("Administrator") relating to the Contest, which are final and binding in all respects.

2. The Contest is sponsored by Premiere Pools ("Sponsor"). The Contest is promoted by 1140 KHTK-Sactown Sports (the "Station" or "Promotional Partner"). The Contest is administered by Bonneville International Corporation ("Administrator"). The weekly prizes are provided by Sponsor. A portion of the Grand Prize is provided by Sports Leisure Vacations, a licensed travel agency located in Sacramento, California ("Grand Prize Provider"). The Sponsor, Station, and Administrator are collectively referred to herein as the "Promotion Parties." The Grand Prize Provider is not a Promotion Party but is subject to the specific obligations set forth in these Official Rules.

3. **HOW TO ENTER.**

a. Contest Overview. This is a "Pick 'Em"-style contest tied to the 2026-27 professional football regular season, covering Weeks 2 through 18. Each Contest week, you will select the team you believe will win each scheduled game played that week (your "Weekly Picks"). Each correct pick is worth one (1) point; each incorrect pick receives zero (0) points. In an event of tie game, both teams will be scored as a losing selection.

b. The maximum point total for each Contest Week (defined below) is up to sixteen (16) points, depending on the number of teams with a bye that week. The maximum cumulative point total for correctly picking the winner of every game played during the Contest period (Weeks 2–18) is 256. The Entrant who earns the most points in a given Contest Week will be declared that week's winner and will receive that week's weekly prize. The Entrant who earns the most cumulative points across all Contest Weeks will be declared the Grand Prize winner. In the event of any tie, whether for a weekly prize or the Grand Prize, the Tiebreaker rules below apply. In addition to selecting game winners each week, Entrants will be asked to predict the final score of one or more designated "Tiebreaker Game(s)," which will be used to resolve ties as described in the Tiebreaker Rules below. A "Contest Week" shall correspond to the official regular-season week

designated by the league for the 2026–27 season (e.g., Week 2, Week 3, etc.), which typically includes games scheduled from Thursday through the following Monday.

c. The Game Period begins at the kickoff of the first Contest Week's game scheduled to take place on Thursday, September 17, 2026 and ends at the completion of the regular season on Sunday, January 10, 2027. The Contest covers Weeks 2 through 18 of the 2026–27 professional football regular season. Week 1 games are not included in this Contest. Exact dates and times are subject to change. Entrants may register for this promotion and begin making their weekly pick choices on Tuesday, September 15, 2026, at 12:01 a.m. (PT) through fifteen (15) minutes before the start of the last listed game in any particular Contest Week through January 10th, 2027. The ability to pick a winner in a game for each regular season week will cease at approximately 15 minutes before the kickoff of each individual game or when an entrant's chosen game has kicked off.

d. To participate in the Contest, visit www.sactownsports.com and follow the links and instructions to enter the Premier Pools Pigskin Pick'em contest and follow the on-screen entry instructions. Fill in all required information. During registration, Entrants will be given the option to opt in to receiving marketing communications from the Sponsor (Premiere Pools). This opt-in is entirely voluntary and is not required to enter or participate in the Contest. Choosing not to opt in will not affect an Entrant's eligibility, chances of winning, or ability to participate in any way. Use of multiple email addresses or identities or of any robotic, automatic, or programmed entry method will result in disqualification. Online Entrants are subject to all notices posted online including but not limited to the Station's Terms of Use and Privacy Policy. Only one (1) online entry per Entrant per week is permitted. Entrants may use only one (1) email address for purposes of entry in this Contest. Online entries will be deemed made by the authorized account holder, defined as the natural person who is assigned to an email address by an internet access provider, online service provider, or other organization responsible for assigning email addresses for the domain associated with the submitted email address, of the email address submitted at the time of entry. Multiple Entrants are not permitted to share the same email address. Entries submitted will not be acknowledged or returned. Proof of submission of an entry shall not be deemed proof of receipt by Station. The Station is not responsible for entries not received due to difficulty accessing the internet, service outage or delays, computer difficulties and other technological problems.

e. To participate in any or all Contest Week(s), you will need to visit your account at sactownsports.com beginning on the Tuesday following the completion of the prior Contest Week's games until each week's Weekly Pick Deadline. Fill in the entry form by selecting the team you believe will win each scheduled game that week. Scoring, winner determination, maximum point totals, and tiebreaker procedures are described in the Contest Overview above and Tiebreaker Rules below.

f. Tiebreaker Rules. Each Contest Week, in addition to picking game winners, Entrants will be asked to predict the final score of one or more designated "Tiebreaker Game(s)." The tiebreaker score is calculated as follows: the differences between the Entrant's predicted scores and the actual final scores for each team in the Tiebreaker Game are added together, and that total is subtracted from 100 possible points. The closer the Entrant's prediction is to the actual score, the higher the tiebreaker score (maximum 100 points per week). Weekly winners will be determined by their additional tiebreaker scores on leaderboard.

- i. Weekly Tiebreakers. The Entrant who correctly predicted the winning team in the designated Tiebreaker Game is considered the winner of that week.
- ii. Overall Season Tiebreaker. The Entrant with the best cumulative tiebreaker score across all Contest Weeks (as displayed on the Overall Leaderboard) will be declared the winner.

g. In any matchup, the team that wins the scheduled game will be scored as a winning selection. The team that loses a scheduled matchup will be scored a losing selection. In the event of a tie, both teams will be scored as a losing selection.

h. Game Postponement, Cancellation, or Rescheduling: In the event that individual games are postponed, canceled, rescheduled, or otherwise not played to a conclusion, the Promotion Parties reserve the right to use a random draw to determine the weekly or overall winners. In the event of a widespread disruption affecting multiple Contest Weeks (including but not limited to a labor stoppage, pandemic, natural disaster, or government action), the Administrator reserves the right to suspend, modify, or terminate the Contest and award the Grand Prize based on Contest standings at the time of disruption, using the tiebreaker rules described herein if necessary.

4. ELIGIBILITY. The Contest is open to individuals who (a) are legal residents of the fifty (50) United States and D.C., (b) are 18 years of age or older at the time of entry, and (c) reside within Station's listening area, except for (i) employees of Sponsor, Station, Administrator, Grand Prize Provider, and their respective affiliates, subsidiaries, and agencies, and members of their immediate family (defined as spouse, parents, children, siblings) or persons living in the same household; and (ii) individuals who have won a prize having a value greater than \$500 in a contest or sweepstakes administered by Station during the ninety-day period preceding the first day on which entries may be submitted in this Contest.

5. WINNER SELECTION.

a. Weekly Prize Winners. Each Contest Week, the Entrant with the highest weekly point total will be declared the weekly prize winner for that week. If a tie exists, the weekly tiebreaker rules described above will apply.

b. Grand Prize Winner. At the conclusion of Week 18, the Entrant with the highest cumulative point total across all Contest Weeks will be declared the Grand Prize winner. If a tie exists, the overall season tiebreaker rules described above will apply.

Decisions of the Promotion Parties with respect to winner selection and the awarding of prizes are final and binding.

c. In case of a tie refer to the tiebreaker rules above. The odds of winning depend on the number of entries received. The winner will be notified by phone and must sign an Affidavit of Eligibility and Release within five (5) business days thereafter. The winner will be deemed a potential winner pending verification of eligibility and delivery of a signed Affidavit of Eligibility and Release. A potential winner must also provide valid, government-issued photo identification. The potential winner must also complete and return an IRS Form W-9 prior to prize payment. The Administrator will issue an IRS Form 1099-MISC for the prize amount as required by law. Failure to respond within the applicable time period will result in prize forfeiture, and Station shall have the option to award the prize to an alternate winner. The return of any prize notification or prize as undeliverable may result in disqualification and selection of an alternate winner. Any income taxes resulting from acceptance of a prize are the responsibility of the winner.

6. By accepting a prize, Participant gives permission to the Promotion Parties to use Participant's name, likeness, city and state of residence, and biographical information for advertising, publicity, and marketing purposes in any media now known or hereafter developed, without further compensation, notification, or right of approval, unless prohibited by law. Participant agrees to execute any document reasonably required by Station to effectuate such permission. Failure or refusal to execute any and all such documents within five (5) business days of Station's request shall constitute grounds for prize forfeiture, and Station shall have the right to select an alternate winner.

7. INDEMNIFICATION. In exchange for the right to participate in the contest, each participant agrees to release, forever discharge, hold harmless, and indemnify the Station, Administrator, Sponsor, and Grand Prize Provider, and their respective officers, directors, agents, parent companies, subsidiaries, sponsors, and employees (the "Released Parties"), from any and all claims, demands and/or causes of action of any nature or kind whatsoever, whether presently known or unknown, foreseen or unforeseen, that arise out of the participant's participation in the contest. The Released Parties are not responsible for:

- a. Typographical or other errors in the printing, the offering, or the administration of a contest or in the announcement of a prize;
- b. Incorrect or inaccurate information, human error, failure, or omission;
- c. Unauthorized human intervention;
- d. Lost, stolen, mangled, misdirected, illegible, incomplete, or late entries;
- e. Entries not received due to difficulty accessing the internet, service outage or delays, computer difficulties and other technological problems or for telephone service outages, delays, busy signals, poor signals or signal interference, accidental disconnection, equipment malfunctions, and any other technological failures of any kind;
- f. Any injury or damage to an entrant's or any other person's computer, mobile device, or other equipment related to or resulting from participating in or downloading any information necessary to participate in any contest; or
- g. Any cancellations, delays, diversions, or substitutions or omissions whatsoever by any transportation providers or any other persons or entities providing any services to entrant(s) and/or winner(s) (and winner's guest(s) if applicable) including any results thereof such as changes in services or location necessitated by same.

Further, the Released Parties are not responsible if any part of a contest cannot be conducted and/or if a prize, either in whole or in part, cannot be awarded due to acts of God, acts of war, natural disasters, weather, acts of terrorism, pandemics, epidemics, public health emergencies, government orders or restrictions, supply chain disruptions, labor disputes, or other factors beyond the Released Parties' control. Station and sponsors are not responsible for technical, hardware, software or telephone or other transmission failures of any kind; lost or unavailable network connections; or incomplete, garbled or delayed computer transmissions whether caused by the Station, users, by any equipment or programming utilized in promotions, games or contests, or by human error which may occur in the processing of submissions, which may limit a participant's ability to participate.

The Released Parties disclaim all liability for any delays, misdelivery, loss, or failure in the delivery of any item sent by mail, courier, express, electronic transmission, or other delivery method.

In addition to releasing the Released Parties as set forth above, each entrant affirmatively agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold the Released Parties harmless from any third-party claim, demand, action, damage, cost, or expense (including reasonable legal fees) that arises from or relates to: (a) the entrant's participation in any contest; (b) the entrant's acceptance, possession, or use of any prize; or (c) any breach by the entrant of any representation, warranty, covenant, or obligation contained in these Contest Rules.

8. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY. Subject to applicable law, by entering the Contest and potentially receiving a prize, Participant agrees to hold the Promotion Parties harmless from any claim, liability, loss, damage (including punitive, incidental, and consequential damages), or expense (including attorney's fees) arising out of or in connection with participation in the Contest or the acceptance, use, or misuse of any prize. The Promotion Parties will not be responsible for (a) late, incomplete, or incorrect entries; (b) Participant's failure to receive a prize notification due to spam, junk email, or other security settings or provision of incorrect or otherwise non-functioning contact information; (c) technical, hardware, or software malfunctions; (d) lost or unavailable network connections; or (e) failed, incorrect, inaccurate, incomplete, garbled, or delayed electronic communications whether caused by the sender or any equipment or programming associated with or used in this Contest, by any human error which may occur in the processing of entries, or by any typographical, technological, or other error in the promotion or administration of the Contest or announcement of the prize. If, in Station's opinion, there is such an error, or there is any suspected evidence of tampering with any portion of the Contest, or if technical difficulties (including viruses and bugs) compromise the integrity of the Contest, Station, in its sole discretion, may cancel or modify the Contest in a manner deemed appropriate by Station. In the event of termination, the winner will be selected from among the eligible entries received as of the date of termination. In the event a dispute arises as to the identity of a potentially winning entrant, entries will be declared made by the name on the online entry form. This Contest is void where prohibited.

The Sponsor (Premiere Pools) is solely responsible for the provision, quality, and fulfillment of all weekly prizes. The Station (KHTK-Sactown Sports) is solely responsible for the provision and fulfillment of the AMEX gift card component of the Grand Prize. Neither the Station nor the Administrator shall have any liability arising from the Sponsor's weekly prizes, and the Sponsor shall have no liability arising from the Grand Prize. The Grand Prize Provider (Sports Leisure Vacations) is solely responsible for the provision, quality, and fulfillment of the travel credit component of the Grand Prize. Neither the Station, the Administrator, nor the Sponsor shall have any liability arising from the Grand Prize Provider's travel credit, including but not limited to airline availability, schedule changes, cancellations, or any acts or omissions of Southwest Airlines or any other carrier.

9. PRIZE.

a. Weekly Prizes (provided by Sponsor): Each Contest Week, the weekly prize winner will receive one (1) RTIC cooler (ARV: \$200). Weekly prizes are furnished by and are the sole responsibility of the Sponsor (Premiere Pools). Total weekly prize value: 17 weeks $\times$ \$200 = \$3,400.

b. Grand Prize: There is one (1) Grand Prize. The Grand Prize consists of two (2) components:

i. AMEX Gift Cards (provided by Station): Two (2) American Express gift cards, each valued at five hundred dollars (\$500), for a combined value of one thousand dollars (\$1,000). The AMEX gift cards are furnished by the Station (KHTK-Sactown Sports). AMEX gift cards combined ARV: \$1,000.

ii. Travel Credits (provided by Grand Prize Provider): Two (2) travel credits, each valued at five hundred dollars (\$500), for a combined value of one thousand dollars (\$1,000), redeemable exclusively through Sports Leisure Vacations. Each travel credit may be applied only toward airfare on Southwest Airlines, booked through Sports Leisure Vacations, subject to availability and applicable airline terms, conditions, and restrictions. Each travel credit is valid for one (1) year from the date of issuance and must be redeemed by contacting Sports Leisure Vacations directly. Any unused portion of a travel credit after the expiration date will be forfeited. The travel credits have no cash value and are not redeemable for cash. The travel credits are not issued by, backed by, or affiliated with Southwest Airlines. They are provided solely by Sports Leisure Vacations and are fulfilled using Sports Leisure Vacations' own resources. Travel credits combined ARV: \$1,000.

Total Grand Prize ARV: \$2,000. The Grand Prize is furnished jointly by the Station (AMEX gift cards) and the Grand Prize Provider (travel credits).

10. CHOICE OF LAW AND FORUM. This Contest is governed by the laws of the United States of America and the State of California, without respect to conflict of law doctrines. As a condition of participating in the Contest, Participant agrees that any and all disputes which cannot be resolved between the parties and causes of action arising out of or connected with the Contest, shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action, exclusively before a court located in Sacramento, California, having jurisdiction. Further, in any such dispute, under no circumstances will Participant be permitted to obtain awards for, and hereby waives all rights to claim, punitive, incidental, or consequential damages, including reasonable attorney's fees, other than Participant's actual, out-of-pocket expenses (i.e., costs associated with entering the Contest), and Participant further waives all rights to have damages multiplied or increased.

11. PRIVACY. Information submitted with an entry is subject to the Privacy Policy stated on www.sactownsports.com/privacy. By entering the Contest, Participant consents to the

collection, use, and disclosure of Participant's personal information as described in the Privacy Policy and these Official Rules. The Administrator may share Participant's information with third-party service providers solely for the purpose of administering the Contest. If a Participant opts in to receiving marketing communications from the Sponsor (Premiere Pools) during registration, the following personal information will be shared with the Sponsor: name, email address, and city/state of residence. The Sponsor may use this information to send marketing communications to the Participant. Opting in, opting out, or withdrawing consent will not affect a Participant's eligibility, chances of winning, or ability to participate in the Contest. The Station will share the Grand Prize winner's name and contact information with the Grand Prize Provider (Sports Leisure Vacations) solely for the purpose of fulfilling the travel credit component of the Grand Prize.
